Language:

STEP -1 Central Idea: Human Beings Interpret The World Around Them Using Their

Lines of Inquiry:

• Characteristics and arrangements of sense organs.

• How sense organs are used to understand and respond to the surroundings.

Discussion on:

Read aloud: "This Tastes" was read to students.

Introduce different tastes and ask the learners how it tastes.

Reinforcement of senses of sight, hearing, and smell.

STEP -2 Language:

Classified Pictures: Transport.

Reinforcement of the sound of the letter- "m-v"

Introduction to the sound of the letter: "w"

I spy game (Identification of initial and ending sound)

Writing: cursive "e", "l".

Math:

Reinforcement of numbers: 1-20

Exercise – After numbers 1 - 10.

Writing numbers: 1 to 15.

Write the number that comes after 1-10.

Sensorial: World map puzzle.

Central Idea: Communities make efforts to create transportation systems that meet their needs.

Lines of Inquiry:

- Features of transportation systems.
- Decision involved in using transportation.
- How systems of transportation respond to changing needs.

Discussion on:

- Modes of transport.
- Features of transportation systems.

Activities:

- Students were asked to match the vehicle to the appropriate mode of transport.
- Students were asked to draw their favourite transport and discussed in which mode of transport they come to school.
